

Join the Bicycling Campaign Across Europe for North Korean Human Rights

LFNKR is joining the bicycling campaign hosted by the organization “Justice for North Korea.” The campaign is to publicize the North Korean human rights issue and bring it to the attention of Europe. To maximize the impact of this campaign, we are calling for as many participants as possible. Those who wish to ride bicycles may do so, but that is not a requirement. Buses will accompany the riders, so it will be possible to ride bicycles on only one or more selected segments of the route, or you may elect to ride the bus only.

During the campaign, press conferences as well as general meetings are planned. There will also be screenings of the movie "Crossing," an inspiring story about North Korean defectors. Press kits will be available for the news media, and a performance will be staged depicting rights abuses of North Koreans. Planned demonstration sites include Chinese Embassies or other Chinese organizations.

Currently, 50 South Koreans – mainly bicycling ladies – are warming up and getting ready, training 100-150 km per day. The eldest member is 74 years of age !

If you are in one of the cities along the route and would like to join the protests and meetings, or if you are able to set up more meetings with local politicians and journalists, or even if you can help with accommodation and venues for the screening, please contact our international coordinator Ji-Hye Park by e-mail (see below).
