Dear Mr. President:

We are writing in response to the tragic events that occurred last week when representatives of your government allowed nine young people to be taken against their will by representatives of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea back to North Korea. Because of our direct knowledge of this incident, we can assure you that these nine persons ranging in age from teenagers to young adults were seeking resettlement to the Republic of Korea, and that the Republic of Korea had made it clear to your government that they were willing to accept all nine children for resettlement. It is also universally known and recognized that North Koreans who have fled their country, as these nine had done, face torture, imprisonment, and even execution when they are forced back to North Korea.

We are writing with two specific requests of your government and asking for your immediate reply to these requests by Wednesday, June 5, when representatives of our North Korea Freedom Coalition wish to meet with your Ambassador to the United States, His Excellency Ambassador Seng Soukahathivon:

First, because the lives of nine young people rests in your hands because of the decision that was made, we make this simple request: that the Laos People's Democratic Republic perform regular visits to these nine children in North Korea, so that you can guarantee they have been welcomed on their return, treated properly, and their rights have been protected and that you share that information with the Republic of Korea who had requested to care for these nine young people. We ask that you confirm your willingness to do that in writing via fax to 703-538-6149.

Second, we request that your government never again put the lives of North Korean men, women and children at risk by forcing them back to North Korea and that you instead return to your previous policy to work on their resettlement to the Republic of Korea, where they have automatic citizenship under the Republic of Korea's constitution. We ask that you confirm your willingness to do this in writing.

We look forward to your response and meeting your Ambassador on Wednesday, June 5 at a time of day that he chooses.
